ADEM Regulatory Requirements

ADEM Admin. Code R. 335-13-4-.21 (1)(c):

“Prior to disposal of industrial waste and/or medical waste, the permittee shall obtain from each generator a written certification that the material to be disposed does not contain free liquids, regulated hazardous wastes, regulated medical wastes, or regulated PCB wastes.”



Waste Approvals Process

Make a waste determination



Complete the proper forms



Submit the proper forms, supporting documentation,
and the appropriate fee and



Receive confirmation of approval

ADEM Admin. Code r. 335-13-1-.03 (126)

- Garbage, rubbish, C/D debris, or ash
- Sludge from wastewater treatment plant, water supply treatment plant, or air pollution control facility
- Other discarded material including:
 - solid, liquid, semi-solid, or contained gaseous material resulting from industrial, commercial, mining, and agricultural operations and community activities
 - materials intended for or capable of recycling, but which have not been diverted or removed from the solid waste stream



Examples of wastes that do not require an approval.

Non friable asbestos

Dead animals (non-lab animals)

Uncontaminated concrete

Household waste

Tires

Office trash

Packing material

Uncontaminated, Untreated Wood

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Approval / profile **NOT** Required



ADEM Special Waste, what is it?

ADEM Admin. Code r. 335-13-1-.03 (131)

“Special wastes require specific processing, handling or disposal techniques as determined necessary by the Department which are different from the techniques normally utilized for handling or disposal.”



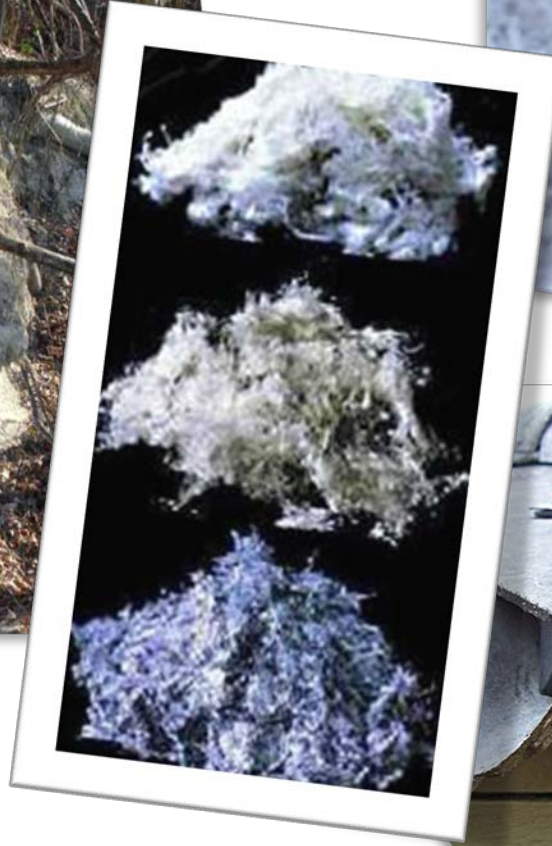
Special Waste Examples

ADEM Admin. Code r. 335-13-4-.26

- Friable Asbestos
- Foundry Sand
- Petroleum Contaminated Wastes
- Municipal Solid Waste Ash
- Wood Ash Waste (added April 2016)

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Asbestos



- No analysis required
- Must be doubled bagged and wetted
- Must be covered at end of day according to 335-13-4-.26(2)

Waste Approvals: What You Do

1. Generator required to perform proper hazardous waste determination for each waste stream
2. Complete the proper form (Form 300)
3. Submit completed form, all supporting documentation, and appropriate fees

4. Receive confirmation of approval before disposal

Note: Disposal approvals are valid for 2 years
(except in the case of foundry sand)

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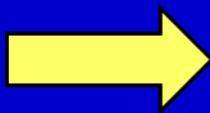

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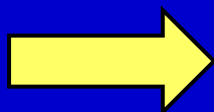

Notify generator of disposal decision via certification letter to be delivered by email

In your certification you requested one or more landfills be approved to receive your waste. Based on our review of the waste and the landfills requested, the waste is approved for disposal in the following landfills:

Landfill 01-01

You should provide this approval letter to the landfill(s) listed above and contact the landfill to determine any special handling requirements for this waste prior to delivery to the landfill. According to ADEM regulations, the landfill may not receive this waste unless it has received a waste certification approval. For waste generated on a routine basis (not a one-time occurrence), another written certification for this waste stream should be submitted to ADEM prior to the expiration date listed above or at any time the process producing the waste changes. Each submittal should include a completed Solid Waste Profile Sheet, any supporting documentation including current analytical, and the appropriate fee. Current analytical consists of analysis performed within the past six months.

If at any time before the expiration date of this certification, new analysis of the waste is performed, the new results will supersede any prior analysis from the time the samples are taken. If the new analysis indicates the waste is still non-hazardous, the waste may continue to be disposed of at the landfill listed above until the expiration date of this certification. If the new analysis indicates the waste is hazardous, this certification is revoked. Each time new analysis is performed on the waste, copies of the analytical results should be provided to ADEM and the landfill until this certification expires. The generator should not dispose of the waste prior to the receipt and review of the sampling results. Furthermore, this approval letter does not exempt ABC Company from complying with all applicable requirements of the ADEM Administrative Code. 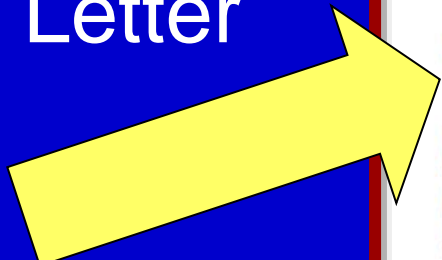

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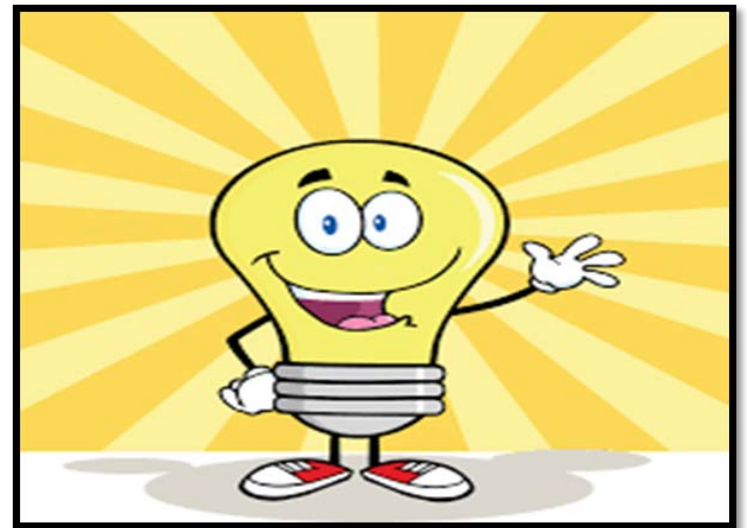
